REGISTRATION REMINDER

I wanted to remind parents and carers that children should be in school by 9 am each morning. The teachers take the registers at 9.05 am so children need to be in class by then. Today we had over 20 late children; if your child walks into school on their own please encourage them to be punctual. Thank you.

SICKNESS AND HOLIDAY ABSENCE

If your child is absent from school due to sickness please inform the school office by 9.30 am. Also, if you know that your child is going to be absent from school, it is imperative that you notify us in writing. Absence request forms are available from the school office, or you can email us at parentcommunications@rosendale.cc. We are required to follow up on the whereabouts of all children who are absent from school. If you have not informed the school the absence will be registered as unauthorised. Please be aware that persistent non-reported absence is reported to the local authority. Thank you for your co-operation.

FLU IMMUNISATION

All children in year's reception to year 5 are being given the opportunity to have a flu vaccination in school on **Monday 12 November**. The vaccine is given as a simple spray up the nose. A consent form and more information went home in book bags earlier this week. Please return completed consent forms to the school office by **Wednesday 31 October**. The NHS Community Health team will be collecting the forms on the 31 October so if your form is late we cannot guarantee that your child will receive the immunisation.
