### **CALLING JUNIOR SCIENTISTS – AGED 3 AND 4 YEARS OLD**

A team of researchers from King's College London is doing a study about pre-schoolers' behaviour in activities that require patience and waiting. The results will give information on toddlers' development of self-control. The study will include a brief pre-study screening questionnaire, a 90 minute university visit (King's College London, Denmark Hill), a series of activities for a parent and child to take part in together and some computerised and game-like tasks. A certificate for the child and a £10 voucher will be offered to participants who complete the university visit.
