Flu Immunisation

We have been contacted by a number of parents whose children missed the flu vaccination on Wednesday. The nursing team has re-opened the portal, if you would like your child to receive the vaccination you must complete the [electronic consent form](#). You need to complete one form per child. **The portal will close on Tuesday 19th October, we suggest you complete it immediately if you want your child to receive the vaccination.** The nursing team have not yet confirmed what date they will be coming back to Rosendale, as soon as we are informed of the date we will let you know.

Please note the following,

- We cannot access the NHS database so we do not know if you have or haven't given consent.
- The nurses **will not** administer the vaccination **without your consent**.
- You do not need to inform the school if you do not want your child to receive the vaccination, **you need to inform the immunisation team. Their contact details are** 02086145495 or email HRCH.ImmunisationTeamMailboxLambeth@nhs.net

- There is an opportunity for you to confirm that you do not want your child to have the vaccination on the consent form.
